
In 2022, Pakistan experienced severe floods that were described as the worst in the country's history. It is estimated to have impacted more than 33 million people.



FRANCE CONTINUES PARTNERSHIP WITH ESAT TO SUPPORT PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES

In 2022, 3C Metal France renewed its partnership with a local institution that provides support and work opportunities to people living with disabilities.

3C Metal France's industrial laundry requirements continue to be subcontracted to an ESAT called Christian Lanusse. In France, an ESAT - or "établissement et service d'aide par le travail" (establishment and assistance service through work) - is an institution that provides opportunities for people with disabilities to develop their knowledge and skills in a working environment.

This particular ESAT has been open since 1982 and provides work opportunities to more than 60 people living with disabilities. Located in the town of Orthez (Pyrénées-Atlantiques), close to 3C Metal France's office and workshop, the institution offers a range of industrial work opportunities in manufacturing, maintenance, cleaning and electrical assembly.



BLOOD DRIVE FOR 3C METAL FRANCE

Nine employees of 3C Metal France volunteered to give blood to L'Etablissement français du sang(EFS) (the French Blood Establishment).

The EFS is the only civil operator of blood transfusions in France. It has 128 collection sites and organizes more than 40,000 mobile blood collections a year.





3C METAL SPONSORS 4L TROPHY RALLY TEAM

4L Trophy is an annual humanitarian rally across the Moroccan desert. The rally starts in France and crosses Spain before arriving in Morocco. During the trip, participants carry school and sports supplies, which are distributed to children in southern Morocco on arrival. 3C METAL BELMET SPONSORS INTERNSHIP PROGRAM FOR PEOPLE LIVING WITH DISABILITIES

3C Metal Belmet is continuing its partnership with an external training service provider, LFP, to sponsor internships for young people living with disabilities.

3C Metal Belmet has chosen to sponsor individuals who are completing a year's learnership in Project Management. They were recently invited to visit 3C Metal Belmet's facilities in Cape Town to learn about the work the company does.

The sponsorship opportunities are part of 3C Metal Belmet's actions in support of the broad-based black economic empowerment (B-BBEE) program by the South African Government. 3C Metal Belmet are proud to support the ambitions of these young people as they forge their career pathways.



3C METAL BELMET SPONSORS CHRISTMAS PARTY FOR CHILDREN'S HOME IN NAMIBIA



SOUTH AFRICAN TEAM CELEBRATES MANDELA DAY BY SUPPORTING CHILDREN FROM UNDERPRIVILEGED COMMUNITIES

In celebration of Mandela Day on 18 July, 3C Metal Belmet in Cape Town donated goods worth R 9,885.64 (\$US580) to Elundini Educare – an organization that provides specialized care to more than 120 children from local settlements in Cape Town who are underprivileged or live with developmental or physical disabilities.
















CLOTHING DONATION TO SOUTH AFRICAN CHILDREN IN NEED

3C METAL BELMET SUPPORTS NATIONAL SEA RESEARCH INSTITUTE


South Africa's National Sea Rescue Institute is a volunteer rescue organization that is on call 24/7. They provide a rescue service for South African waters, educate communities and strive to evolve and extend their water-safety initiatives through empowerment and visibility.

3C Metal Belmet donated towards four pink rescue buoys and the institute's drowning prevention awareness program. The amount contributed was R 15,000.00 (\$US880).

Placed strategically on signs at selected inland rivers, dams and at beaches, the institute's bright pink buoys act as a reminder to take care if there are no lifeguards on duty and, in the event of someone getting into difficulty in the water, they can be used as emergency flotation until help arrives. Their bright pink color allows them to be easily seen.







CLOTHES, COMFORT BLANKETS DONATED TO SOUTH AFRICA'S FORENSIC SEXUAL ASSAULT UNIT OF VICTORIA HOSPITAL

3C Metal Belmet donated R 60,000 (\$US3,520) worth of clothes and comfort blankets for victims of sexual assault who are in the care of the Clinical Forensic Unit (CFU) of Victoria Hospital.

The CFU of Victoria Hospital is a dedicated unit that medical and psychological needs in a sensitive, caring and deliver a 24-hour medicolegal service to rape victims. A multidisciplinary team of professionals assisting with the

CALEDON ANIMAL WELFARE DONATION

Caledon Dieresorg is an animal welfare sanctuary, located in the Western Cape province of South Africa, that helps nurse sick animals back to health and find them homes.

The funds went to the organization's spay and neuter program which aims to keep the local stray dog and cat population low.

Those receiving treatment are from ages as young as 2 years old and the facilities have expanded over the years to 10 classrooms, a physiotherapy room, a jacuzzi for
